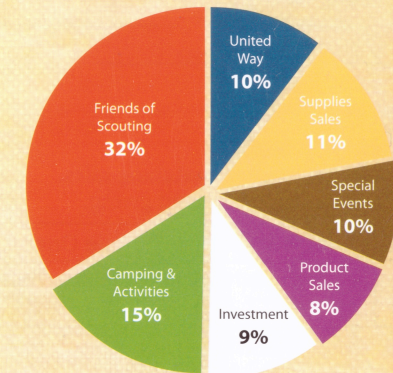

Total Budget: \$680,000

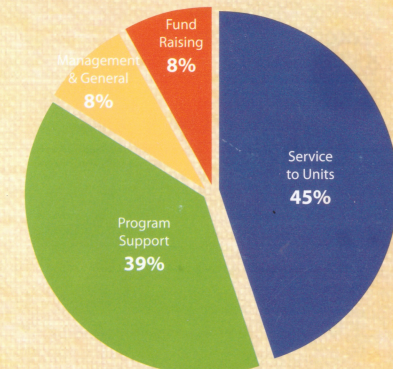
Income
